**GLOBAL PHOTOGRAPHY** An exhibit of black-and-white photography by Machiel Botman, which opens tonight, loosely follows the artist's life over the past 25 years. The self-taught photographer's show includes images from France, Germany, Italy, Australia, Belgium, America, and his birthplace, the Netherlands. Mr. Botman's camera captures a child rushing toward his mother, a snow-covered table shaped like a Star of David, and a series of blurred roads, rivers, and forests.
