1957-62	Photographed in Southam Street, North Kensington and was active as a photojournalist
Late 1960s	Taught photography at the Bath Academy of Art, Corsham
1970s	Focused on landscape photography and worked in Rhodes, Corfu and Dubrovnik
1975	Moved to Lyme Regis, Dorset
1986	Retrospective exhibition at the Victoria & Albert Museum revived interest in his work
1989	Southam Street work was the subject of a BBC TV Timewatch film
2006	Lucie Award, New York for Achievement in Documentary
2007	Photograph chosen as poster image for Tate Britain's <i>How We Are: Photographing Britain</i>
